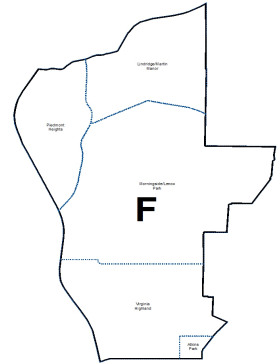

3. Reports by City Representatives (Fire, Police, Council Members, etc.)

Atlanta Police Department – Major Propes provided an update. Car break-ins continue to be a major issue in NPU F, 9 cars were broken into the week of May 12, alone. There have been some arrests, some of the perpetrators are homeless people looking for change or anything else of value, but there are some more organized groups stealing from cars in NPU F, including the BGO (Bust and Grab Organization), who have been seen operating in a 1987 tan or gold color Cadillac and a maroon Buick.

Noise violations at EROS continue. The DJ was cited for the last noise complaint. The situation continues to be monitored by the APD. There have been multiple complaints from the Monroe Place apartment complex across the street.

Atlanta Fire Department – Battalion Chief Ken Byers – Station 15 on 10th Street provided an update on the furlough situation. He indicated that NPU F was not greatly affected by brown-outs.

AFD will be holding open houses on June 6th and 7th. In addition, the next Citizens Fire Academy will be held starting on June 6th. For more info, call the AFD at 404-597-3150.

AFD reminds residents that they should treat all downed wires as live power until AFD arrives on the scene and makes a determination.

Atlanta Parks – Ken Gillette – The Rocking Horse for John Howell Park is on its way – it is being made in Denmark and the Parks Department does not have a definite delivery date yet.

Atlanta Jazz Festival is still free, it will occur in Grant Park over Memorial Day weekend, but the Jazz Festival also includes 31 Days of Jazz, which includes many venues and many events.

The City's first Sprayground is to open on Thursday May 21 at Center Hill Park. Camp Best Friends, for children ages 5-16 and seniors over the age of 50 starts June 1 and runs through July 24th from 7:30 am until 6 pm. Extended camp is available at 4 locations from July 27th through August 7th.
